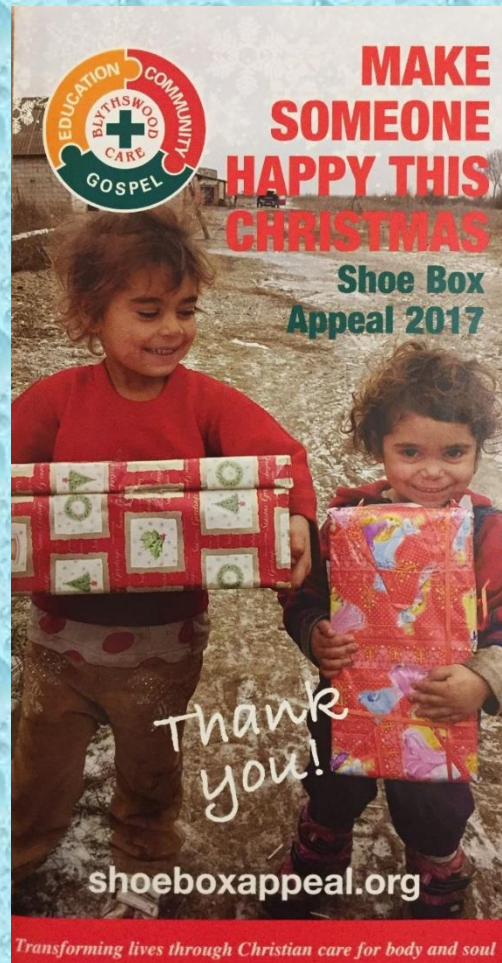






# 2017 Shoebox Appeal

The congregation are asked to donate filled shoeboxes for Blythwood Care at our Harvest Service **next week**. Leaflets are available now.



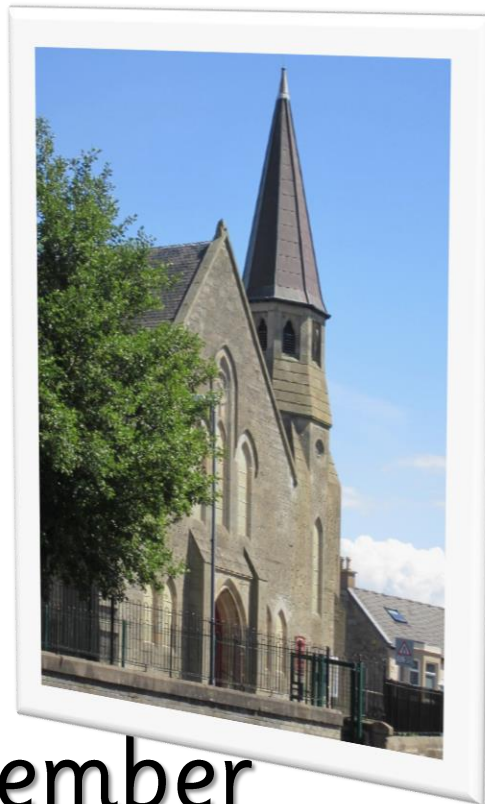

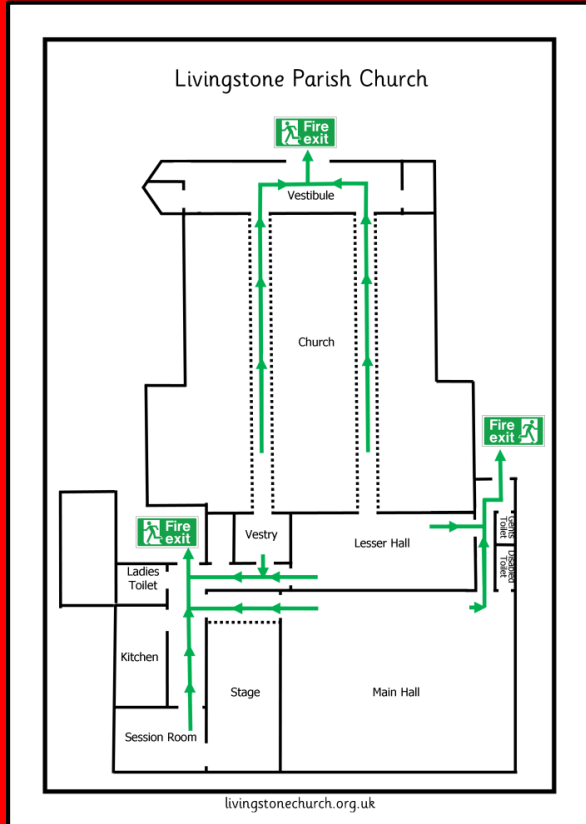
