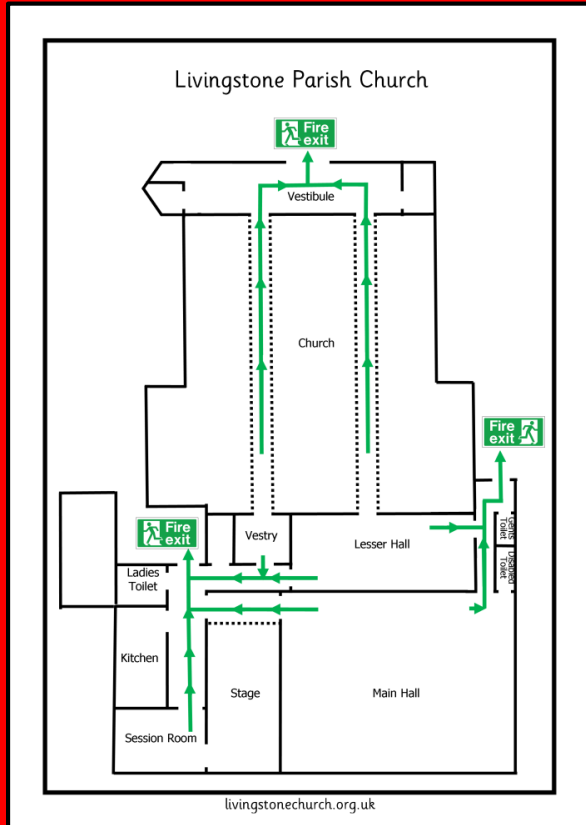
# Security Notice
