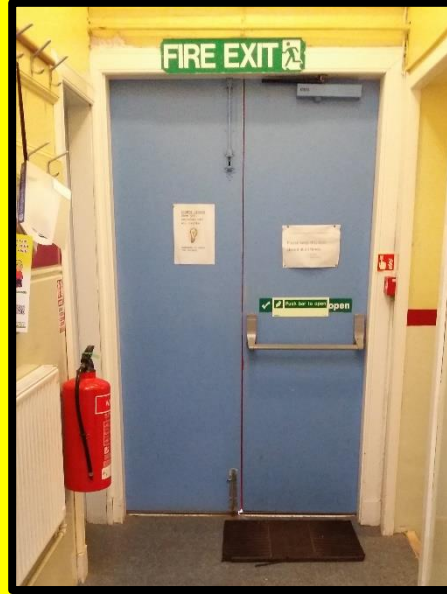

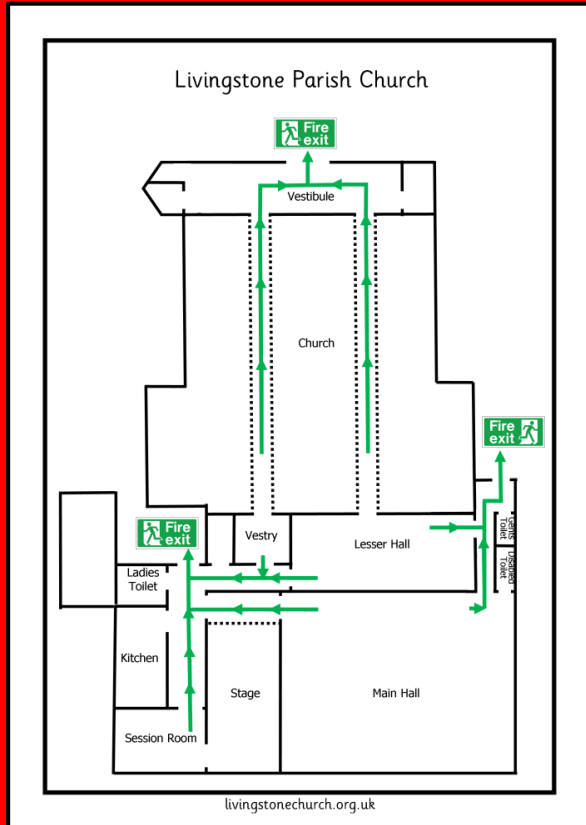
Security Notice
