Joint Session Meetings

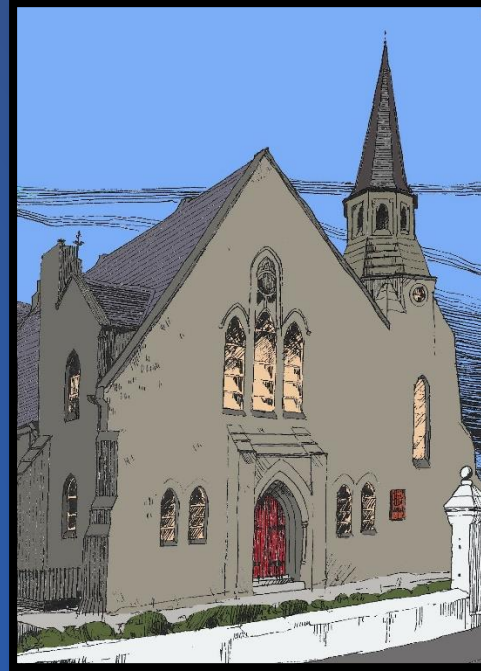

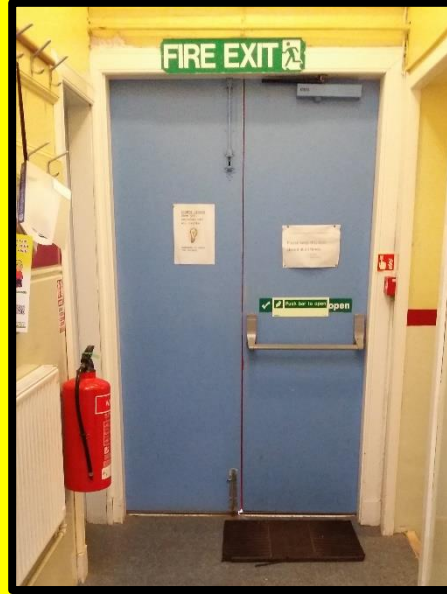

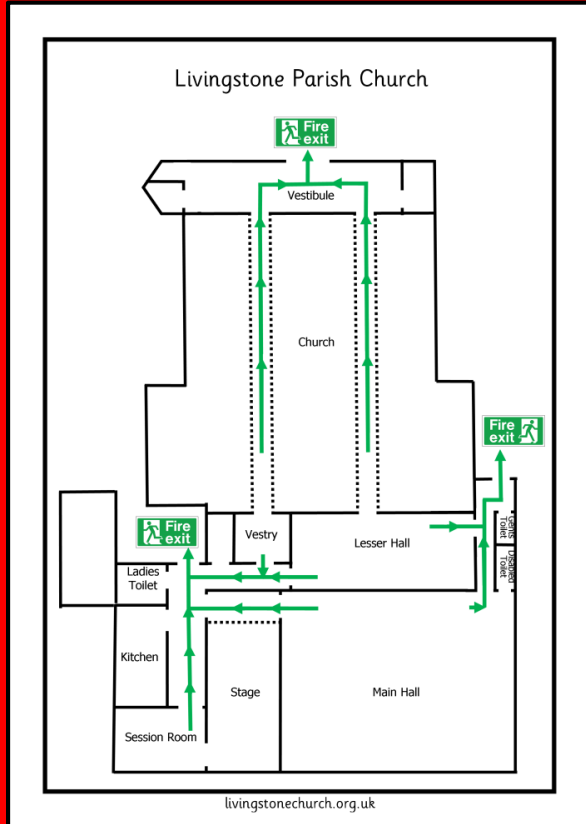
Security Notice
