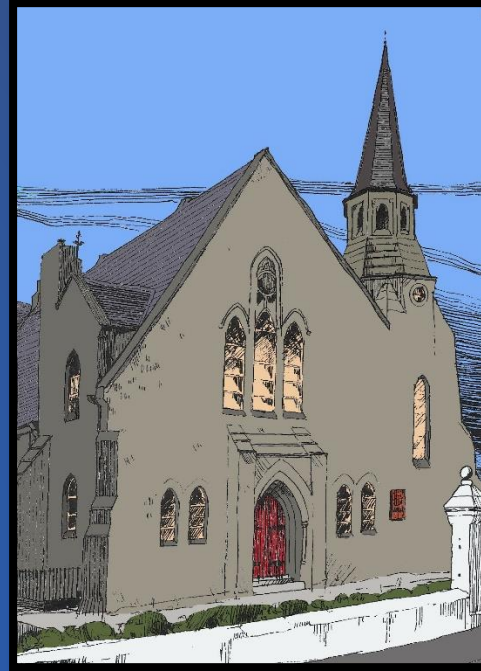

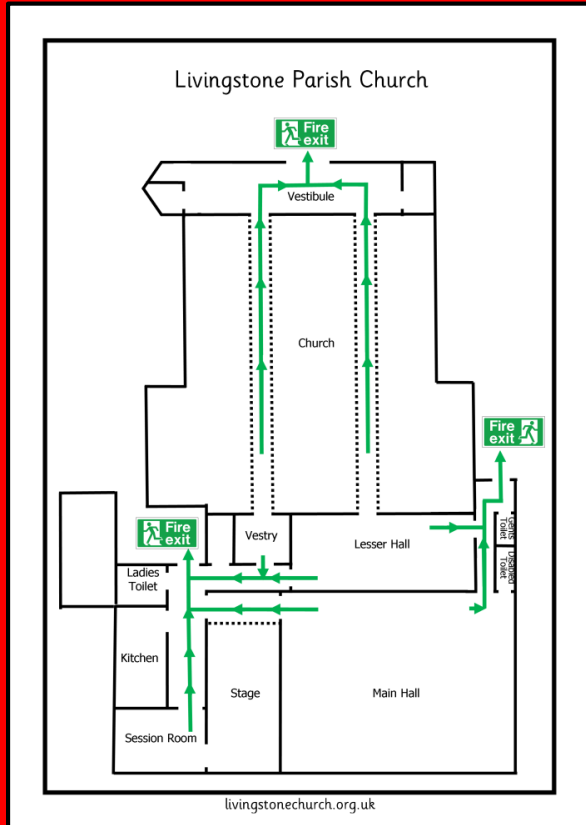
Security Notice
