These will be distributed by North Ayrshire Foodbank to those in need.





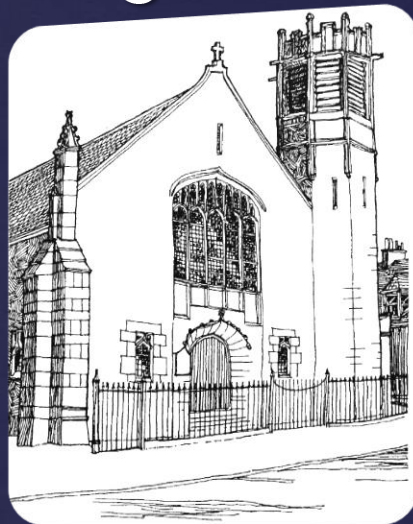
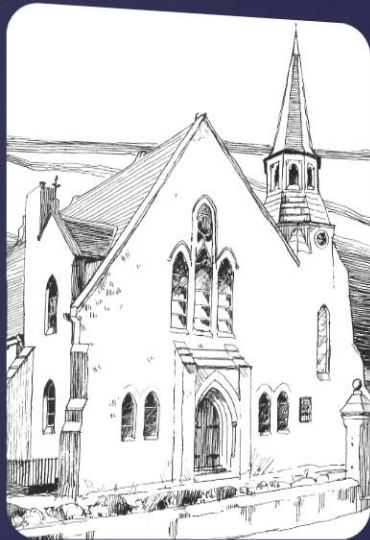
2018 Shoebox Appeal
