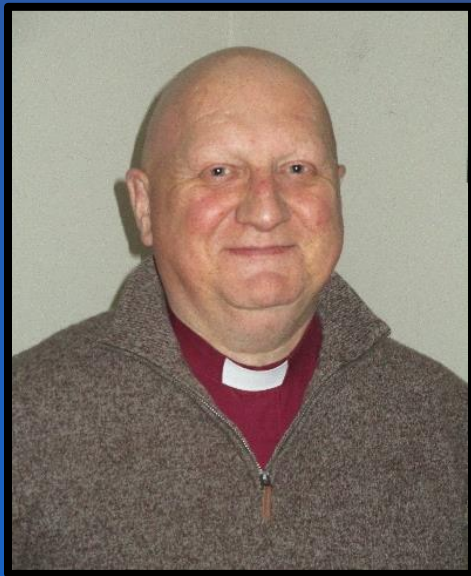

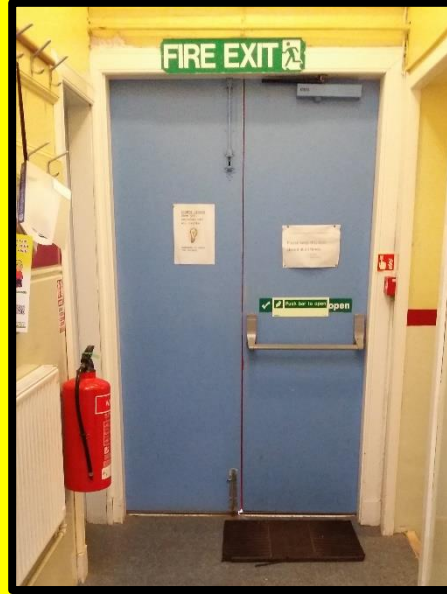

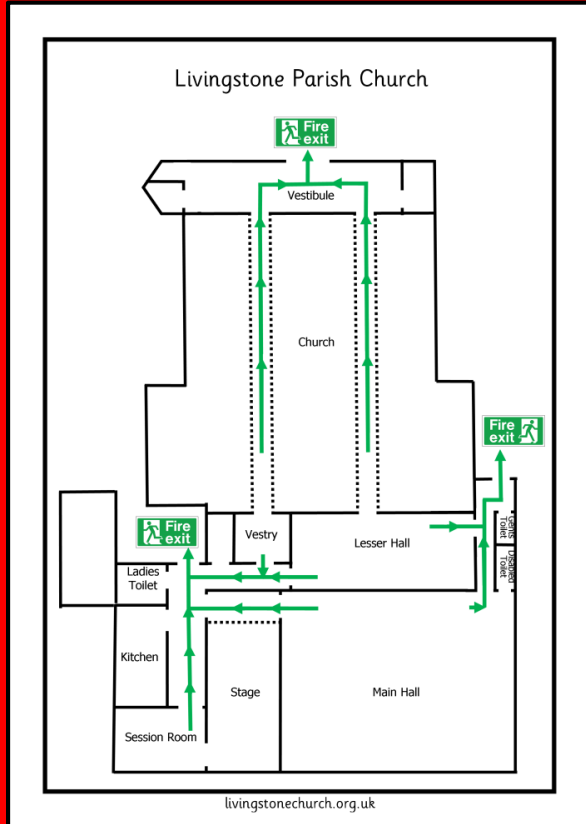
Security Notice
