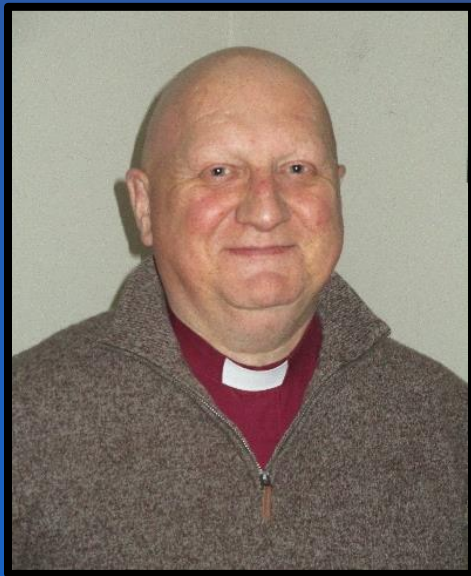

The Scottish Maritime Museum has started a project to collect oral histories from the local area as part of the Garnock Connections Landscape Partnership Scheme. 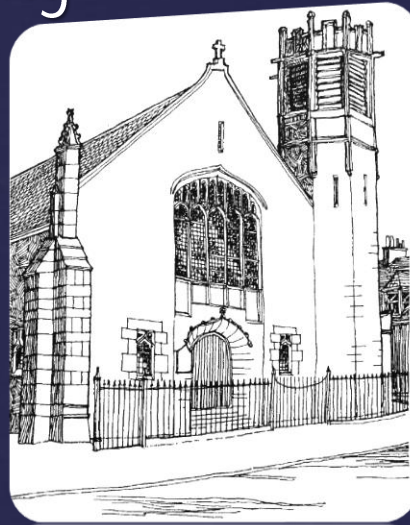

# Security Notice

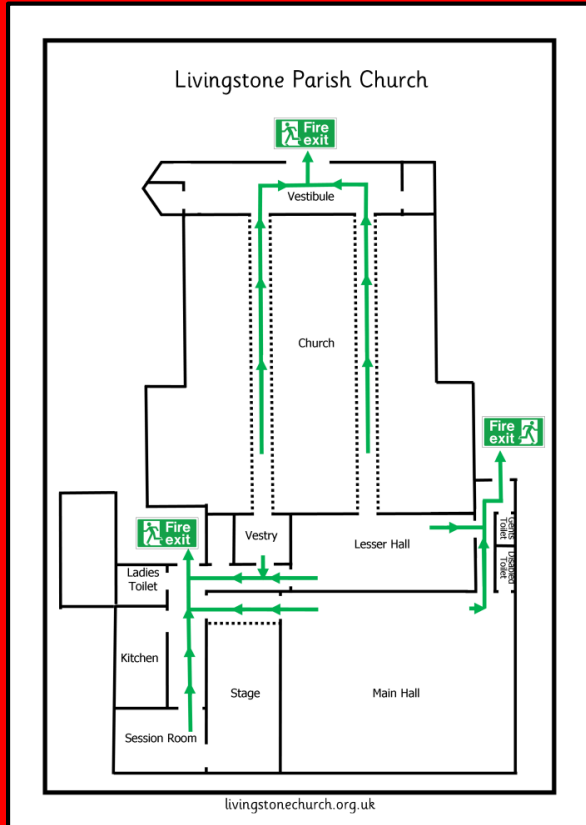


For the safety and security of everyone and everything within the Church buildings, please **DO NOT** wedge the side door open. This applies to everyone!
