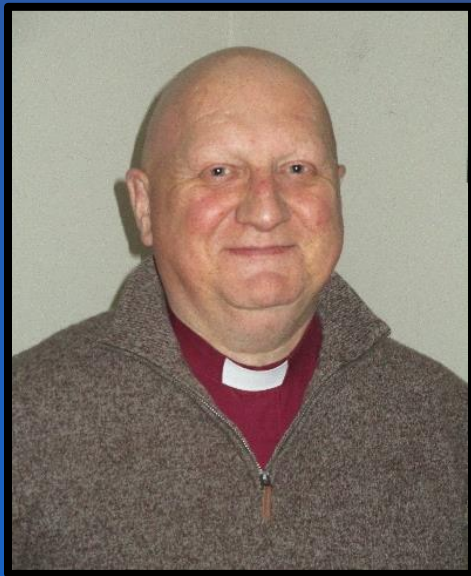

Retiring Offering

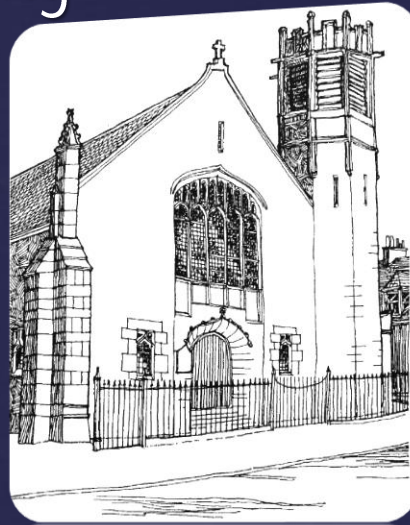


There will be a retiring collection after this morning's worship for the work of the Church.

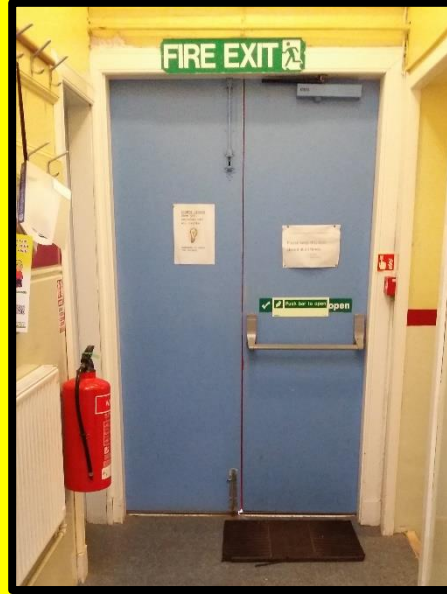

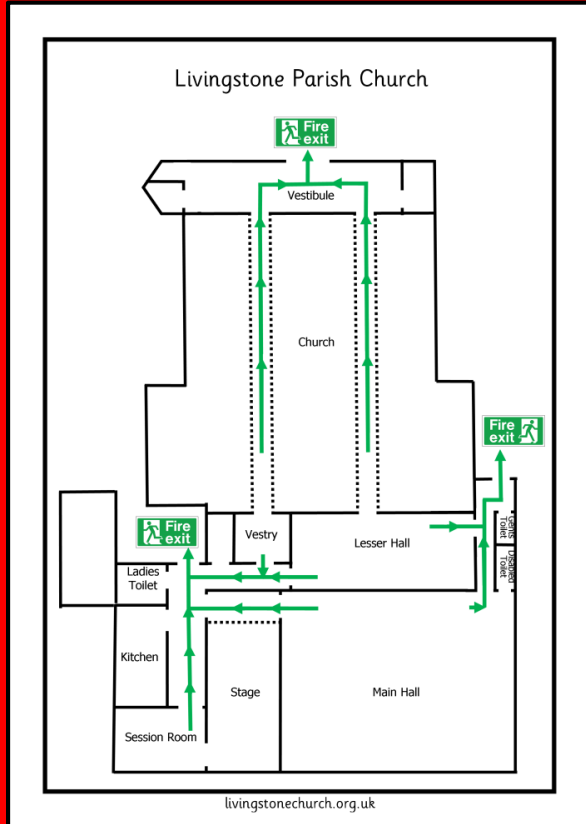
Security Notice
