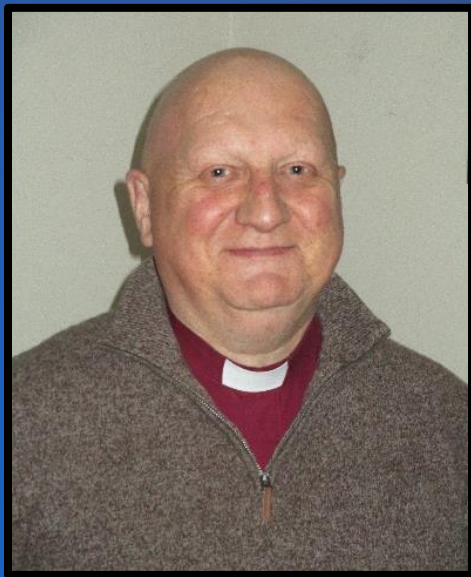

The World Day of Prayer will this year be held in Livingstone Church on Friday 1st March at 2pm.





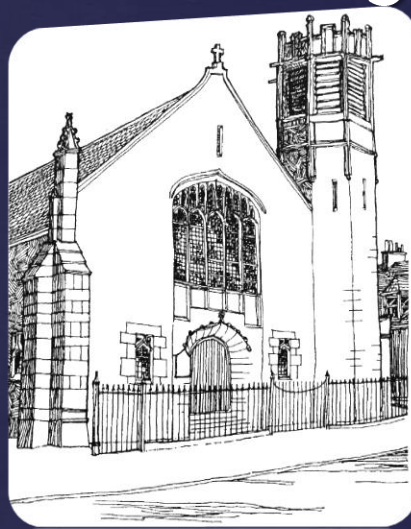
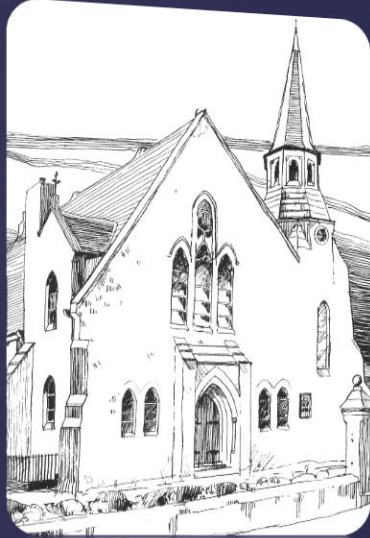

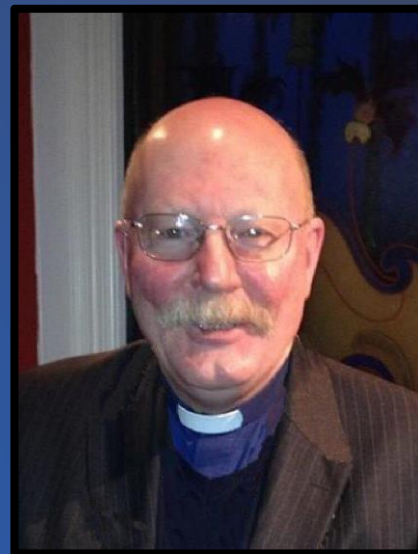
