

There will be a retiring collection after this morning's worship for the work of the Church.







The opening meeting of the Guild will be on Tuesday 3rd September at 1.30pm in the large hall.



Security Notice






For the safety and security of everyone and everything within the Church buildings, please **DO NOT** wedge the side door open. This applies to everyone!
