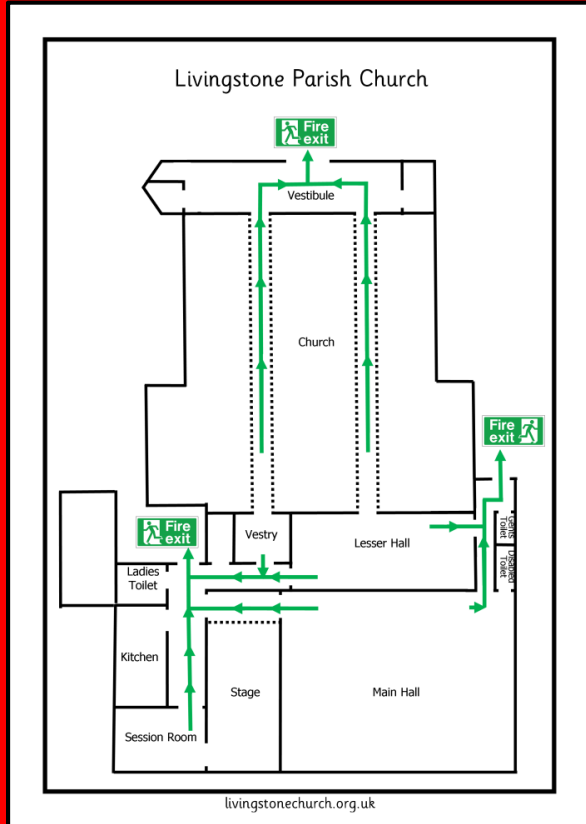
Security Notice
