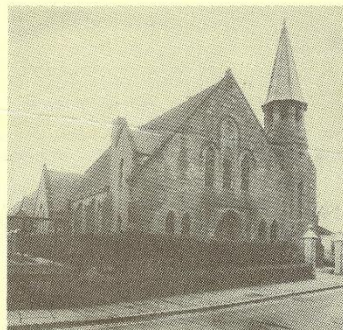

HOW DID WE GET IT?

Jubilee Booklet 1937 — 'Towards the end of the nine years' ministry of the Rev. Joseph Forrest the need for a larger church became more apparent — Mr. Forrest initiated a movement for a new church in 1883. The congregation was very enthusiastic and donations poured in to reward the zealous activities of the many willing collectors. Many of the gifts to the building fund constituted sacrifice, and the people, because they loved their Saviour and their church, gave according as the Lord had blessed them. By 1885 £700 had been gathered in — Mr. Livingstone (Joseph Forrest's successor) set to work with great zeal to raise the remaining £1,300, ably supported by enthusiastic office-bearers. In less than two years from his induction a fine new church was ready for use."

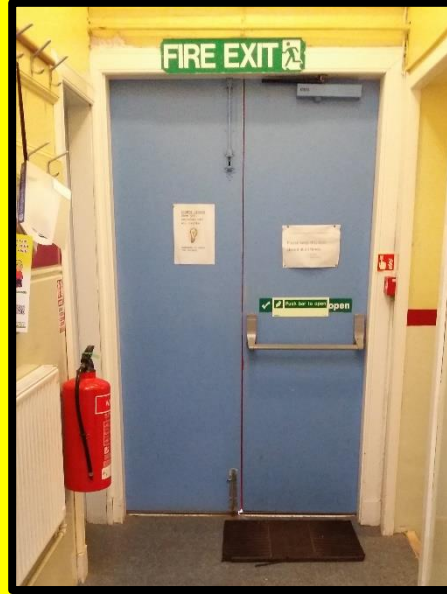

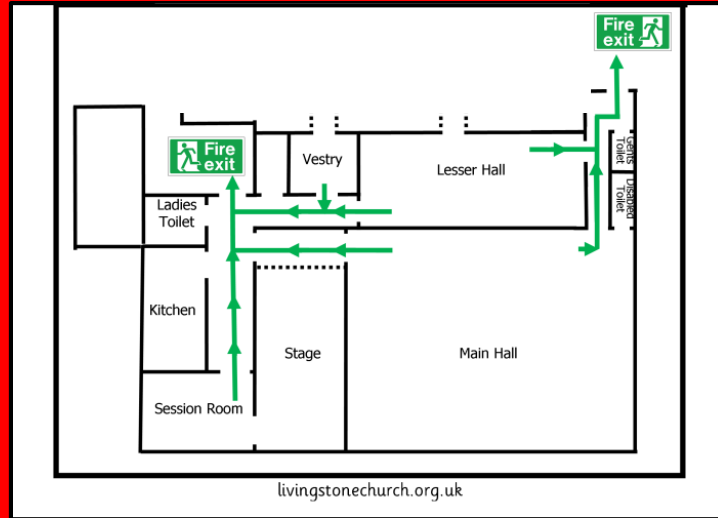
Security Notice
