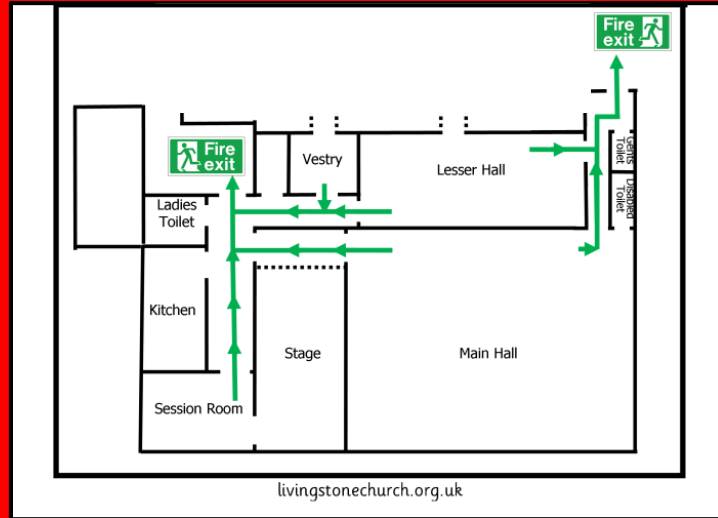
Security Notice
